



**This podcast from Statue Cruises provides information on how to book tickets and how to get a monument pass**

Welcome to Statue Cruises. This podcast provides information about getting access to the Statue Museum, the pedestal of the Statue of Liberty and the observation deck at the base of the Statue. The interior of the Statue, including the crown, is closed to the public.

Monument passes are provided free of charge, but a limited amount are distributed each day. How you get access depends on which type of ticket you book. Please listen to following to learn more about getting a monument pass.

If you know the day and time of your visit, you can book a Reserve ticket. When booking a reserve ticket in advance, either online, by phone or in person, any available monument passes will automatically be provided for every ticket you purchase. If there are no longer passes available for that time you can either purchase a ticket for the next available time that has a monument pass or purchase a ticket that does not include a monument pass. There are passes that are allocated for same day distribution so you can ask at the ticket booths on site or check with rangers on Liberty Island to see if any passes are available.

If you do not know what time and day you are going to visit, you should purchase a flex ticket. The Flex ticket allows you to select any three day period during which you can make your visit. Monument passes are not automatically distributed with flex tickets, but you can request one on the day of your visit either at the ticket booth at your departure location or with the rangers on Liberty Island. If passes are available they will provided to you. That's it for this podcast. We look forward to your visit.
